1. TIS THE SEASON! HOLIDAY EMERGENCIES & CONCIERGE HOURS

A timely reminder for true emergencies during the holidays (Police/Fire/Injury) call 000. Tenants should contact their property managers for issues inside their apartments. See below for more information:

- Loss of power check your fuse board in your apartment and confirm all switches are in the ON position if this isn't the problem, check with a neighbour to see if their power is out and if so call Western Power (13 13 51) for info about area power outages and also BStrata during office hours on 9382 7700 or after hours on 1300 722 445. If it is just your apartment tenants should call their Property Manager.
- Loss of water residents should alert the Council of Owners call 0409 430 521.

2. TIS THE SEASON TO BE JOLLY! (but not too jolly)

It is the season to be jolly but can we ask for every resident's consideration when hosting Christmas and New Year parties. Unfortunately the BM team has had **several complaints recently about loud music, screaming from balconies and generally untidy behaviour at unsociable hours.** Please be especially aware during week nights that not everyone is on holidays!!

- NOISE travels in apartment blocks. Keep the **music volume down** and note that your balcony party will keep everyone around you awake so move inside at a respectable hour. It is just not the midnight owls, we have had complaints from shift workers being woken by the early birds banging and jumping around at 5am.....so as suggested, be aware and considerate.
- One more consideration **smoke drifts up and around** on a still night, so if you are smoking on your balcony please be aware you will disturbing the clean air space of those above, and around you, and does not make for good neighbourly relations. NO smoking is permitted at the community Rooftop.



3. TIS THE SEASON FOR EXCESS WASTE DISPOSAL

- We all know what Christmas means loads of wrapping, polystyrene, plastic and generally an overflow of packaging! Please be aware that the recycle bins on your level will fill up quickly so ensure **ONLY recyclables go in the yellow bins** NO polystyrene in the yellow bins OR the blue suez bins in the B1 bin area. The blue suez bins (we know this is a cracked record) are ONLY for flattened cardboard.
- The area around the blue suez bins is NOT for the dumping of your broken or unwanted goods. It is your responsibility to dispose of these items at the tip. This area has cameras and we will pass the handyman's tip bill onto repeat offenders. There will be an extra red bin next to the blue suez bins for polystyrene etc to assist with excess packaging.
- AND kitty litter! The cleaners report that kitty litter is coming down the rubbish chutes with insufficient bagging and explodes all over the bin room floors. Please double bag or assist by carrying the kitty litter to the red bin in the B1 car park.

4. TIS THE SEASON TO BE NAUGHTY- PARKING & SECURITY

- LOTS of visitors? And you need somewhere for them to park. So please can all residents use their correct car bays in the basement and not park in the visitor bays for convenience. At no times are the electric car bays to be used – UNLESS you own an EV. Permit Parking bays are ONLY for those who have a permit – please display on your dashboard.
- Please be vigilant with security by not allowing access via the lobby or garages to anyone you do not know.
